-Gain to Company D., transferred from Battery C. per Special Order No 2, effective 11 July
Jul-Aug 63:
-Capt, Co. D.: present, transferred from Capt Battery C., by S.O. no 2 "A. & I. Gen Office Woodstock July
11 1863, pay due as commanding Battery since June 20 1863."
Sep 63:
-Absent on sick leave for 20 days per Special Order 360, HQ Dept of Washington, Sept 26, '63

-Capt, Co. D.: present, commanding battery
Nov 63:
-Absent on "y.c.m" per Special Order 223, HQ Dept of Washington, Oct 31, '63
Nov-Dec 63:
-Capt, Co. D.: present, commanding battery since last muster
Jan-Feb 64:
-Capt, Co. D.: present, commanding battery since last muster
Mar-Apr 64:
-Capt, Co D.: present, commanding battery since last muster. Absent on furlough from Apr 15, '64 to Apr
29, '64 per S.O. as noted below.

 May-Jun 64:
 -Commanding Co. D since last muster. Absent on furlough from April 15, 1864 to April 29, 1864 per Special Order HQ, Dept of Washington, April 15, 1864
 Jul-Aug 64:
 -Co. D., transferred Jul 24 '64 by promotion to maj.
 Aug 1 '64:
 -Near Frederick MD
 Oct 64:
 -Absent on leave of absence per S.O. no. 230, HQ VI A.C.
 Dec 64:
 -Present, commanding regiment, signs return
 Mar 10, 1865 (day uncertain):
 -"I have the honor to request leave of absence for twenty days for the purpose of visiting my father who has been long an invalid, and whose health has much declined of late. I also desire to transact significant private business in Vermont and Central New York."
 Mar 65:
 -Absent on leave of absence for 20 days per S.O. 61, HQ Army of the Potomac, 14 Mar '65
 May 26, 65:
 -General Order no. 97, appointed Lt Col by brevet for "distinguished gallantry in the several engagements in the Shenandoah Valley, to date from Oct 19, 1864."
 Jun 9, 65:
 -Camp near Washington D.C., promoted from Major to fill vacancy caused by promotion of Lt Col Hundson
 Jun 24, 65
 -Defences of Washington, Transferred to command of Batty D., 1st VT Arty by R.O. no 9.
 July 1, 65:
 -Major, Camp in field near Frederick, MD; promoted from Capt to Major to fill vacancy caused by the promotion of Major George Chamberlin
 Mar-Apr 65:
 -Major, present
 June 2 65:
 -Lt Col; Camp near Washington DC; promoted from Major to Lt Col to fill vacancy caused by promotion of Lt Col Hundsen
